NOVEL CONTRIBUTIONS OF THE THESIS

1. The thesis systematizes, supplements, refines, and deepens theoretical issues concerning the prevention of exit and entry-related crimes committed by Vietnamese citizens. Specifically, it clarifies concepts, characteristics, and the role of prevention; foundations and principles of prevention; content and preventive measures; coordination among relevant stakeholders; and international cooperation in preventing such crimes.

2. The thesis provides a fundamental, objective, and comprehensive assessment of the current situation of preventing exit and entry-related crimes committed by Vietnamese citizens. Based on research findings, it analyzes the nature and causes of these crimes; evaluates the organization and operation of relevant forces; examines international cooperation; and reviews the implementation of preventive measures. It also assesses the results achieved, identifies limitations and shortcomings, and explains the underlying causes of these deficiencies in preventing such crimes.

3. The thesis offers forecasts of crime trends and proposes feasible and comprehensive solutions aimed at strengthening the prevention of exit and entry-related crimes committed by Vietnamese citizens in the coming period.
