INFORMATION ON NEW POINTS OF THE DISSERTATION

Dissertation topic: Law on international cooperation of Vietnam in criminal asset recovery

Major: Criminal Law and Criminal Procedure

The dissertation is the first research work to systematically and relatively comprehensively research the theoretical and practical aspects of law on international cooperation of Vietnam in criminal asset recovery, specifically:

- The dissertation clarifies theoretical issues, thereby creating a theoretical framework on the law on international cooperation of Vietnam in criminal asset recovery; determines the need and level of internalization of international cooperation regulations in criminal asset recovery of international law into national law, highlighting the complex interaction between national law and international treaties.

- The dissertation's analysis and evaluation of the current state of law and practical implementation of law on international cooperation of Vietnam in criminal asset recovery are new points that no previous research work in this field has addressed these points in Vietnam.

- The dissertation clarifies the need to refine the law and enhance the effectiveness of its practical implementation of the law on international cooperation of Vietnam in criminal asset recovery, thereby proposing key solutions to improve the law on international cooperation of Vietnam in criminal asset recovery. These solutions focus on amending and supplementing current Vietnamese legal documents, such as: Criminal Procedure Code , Law on Legal Assistance, Law on Anti-Corruption and Law on Anti-Money Laundering. Concurrently, the dissertation emphasizes the importance of Vietnam proactively

and more deeply participating in relevant international treaties in this field.

- The solutions proposed in the dissertation to enhance the effectiveness of international cooperation in criminal asset recovery serve as a valuable resource for research and training. They contribute to the development, refinement, and implementation of laws regarding international cooperation in Vietnam, particularly in the area of criminal asset recovery. This work holds significant practical importance in the context of deepening international integration.
